



## **JOB DESCRIPTION**

**Job title: School Administrator**  
**Reports to: Headteacher**

### **1. Key Purpose of Job**

Under instruction/guidance of Head teacher and Senior Leadership Team, to provide routine general administrative support to the school.

### **2. Key Duties**

#### Organisational

- Undertake reception duties, answering routine telephone calls, face to face enquires and signing visitors into the school
- Greeting Trust visitors and escorting them to their meeting place
- Produce and report on daily pupil meal uptake and liaise with school kitchen
- Assist with welfare duties, liaising with parents / staff etc.
- Assisting with arrangements for visits by school trips, events etc
- Responsible for Admissions
- Provide routine clerical support e.g. photocopying, filing, emailing, complete standard forms, respond to routine correspondence
- Maintain manual and computerised records/management information systems
- Produce lists/information/data as required e.g. pupils' data
- Undertake typing, word-processing and other IT-based tasks including newsletters, diaries, emails and websites
- Take notes at meetings, as and when required.
- Sort and distribute mail
- Undertake administrative procedures
- Maintain and collate pupil reports
- Monitor and maintain attendance records

## Resources

- Operate relevant equipment/ICT packages (e.g. Word, Excel, databases, spreadsheets, internet, website, publisher, eschools, Bromcom, ParentPay, CPOMs)
- Provide general advice and guidance to staff, pupils and others

3. The H&S Administrator duties are part of the wider Trust central operations team where they will liaise with colleagues regularly.

### **Main duties and Responsibilities:**

#### **Daily checks:**

- Monitoring key box – to ensure all returned
- Site walk around – visual check and inspection of the site to pick up the following:
  - Site is safe and free from hazards
  - Car park – clear of hazards
  - Playground – clear of hazards
  - Fire exits – clear of debris
  - Lights - working
  - Perimeter – security safeguarding
  - Toilets- working
  - Security – CCTV – intruder alarm working
  - Forest area – free from hazards

#### **Weekly:**

- Visual checks of
  - Double glazing
  - Legionella – outside taps
  - Signage

#### **Termly**

- Drills – fire drills
- Testing core points

Obviously, there is an onus on reminding all staff they have a responsibility for health and safety and should report faults and issues as they occur.
